Project awards

Southern Cross Electrical Engineering Limited (“SCEE Group”) is pleased to announce that its Heyday and Trivantage Manufacturing subsidiaries have been awarded a range of projects totalling over \$100m. Heyday has won the following:

- In NSW, Watpac Construction Pty Limited has awarded Heyday a contract for the design and construction of the electrical, associated communications, security, and nurse call works for the new Shellharbour Hospital which is part of Illawarra Shoalhaven Local Health District’s New Shellharbour Hospital and Integrated Services Project. This new hospital will play a significant role in the health service’s network and will become the district’s specialist elective surgical centre with facilities for emergency and critical care, medicine and surgery, and mental health, rehabilitation, and ambulatory care. This award will become the second hospital project that Heyday is currently constructing in the region, alongside the Shoalhaven Hospital Redevelopment Project previously announced to the ASX on 8 June 2023. Works are scheduled to commence immediately and are expected to be completed by March 2027.
- Heyday has been awarded three further packages of electrical works from J Hutchinson Pty Ltd at two hyperscale data centres in NSW where it has already been working. The packages are due for completion by the end of April 2025.

Trivantage Manufacturing has received a series of orders for its products across a range of sectors and geographies due for delivery on or before June 2026 as follows:

- From the Safety Focused Performance Joint Venture the supply of Outdoor Motor Load Control Kiosks for installation on a Water Treatment Plant in Victoria.
- From The Joint Venture - McConnell Dowell Constructors (Aust) Pty Ltd and BMD Constructions Pty Limited the manufacture and supply of a transportable switchroom for the Gladstone Area Water Board’s Fitzroy to Gladstone Pipeline in Queensland.



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- From Klenner Murphy Electrical Pty Ltd the supply of low voltage switchboards for the Dexus Waterfront Place Redevelopment in Brisbane.
- From ACCIONA Construction Australia Pty Ltd the supply of Control System Cabinets for the Western Harbour Tunnel in Sydney.
- From the SPARK NEL DC JV the supply of Remote I/O Modules for the North East Link in Melbourne.
- From NuEnergy Infrastructure (NEI) Pty Ltd the supply of low voltage switchboards and power distribution boards for the Supernode BESS Stage 2 in Brisbane.

Commenting on the above, SCEE Group Managing Director Graeme Dunn said “I am pleased to be announcing our largest ever hospital contract award which builds on Heyday’s longstanding record of successful delivery of projects in the healthcare sector.

I also note the range of orders Trivantage Manufacturing has received which, together with its two awards that we announced to the ASX on 11 December 2024, means its order book is now at a record level.

And considering across this over \$100m of projects, only further reinforces the theme I was expounding in that previous announcement which is of SCEE’s many touchpoints into Australia’s infrastructure pipeline.”
