

Veris secures \$5.15 million of additional work on the Western Sydney Airport SSTOM project

- Veris secures an additional \$5.15 million in multi-disciplinary engineering, monitoring and cadastral works on the Western Sydney Airport SSTOM project to be completed in CY2025.
