Together with VAFA's 15,000+ players and Westfield Sports High School, this partnership strengthens HITIQ's reach in Australia's community sports market. PROTEQT, a boil-and-bite smart mouthguard, integrates advanced impact sensors, symptom assessment, and telehealth services, addressing the urgent need for accessible concussion management at the grassroots level. HITIQ targets 100,000+ athletes aged 12 and over in the first year of PROTEQT's commercial rollout, commencing this month.

Existing agreements with the AFL, United Kingdom Sports Institute, and English Premier League underpin HITIQ's elite sports credibility, fuelling its consumer market expansion. With additional community and regional football, rugby league, and rugby union partnerships nearing completion, HITIQ is poised for significant growth.

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Driving Growth

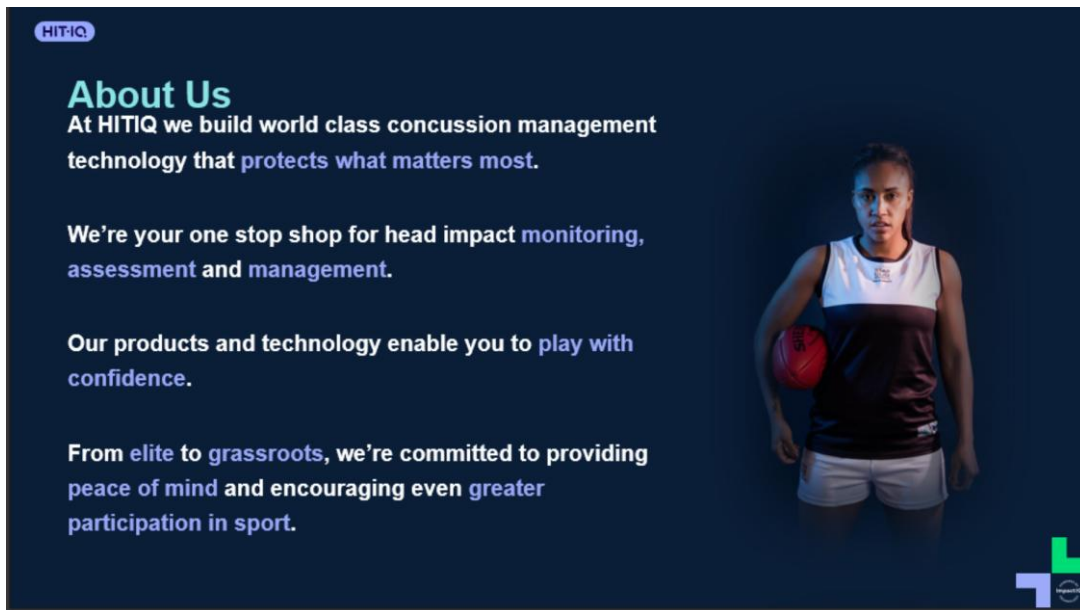
