Request for Voluntary Suspension – Vinyl Group Ltd (ASX: VNL)

Vinyl Group Ltd (ACN: 106 513 580) (Vinyl Group) requests a voluntary suspension be implemented for its ordinary shares (ASX Code: VNL) under Listing Rule 17.2 prior to commencement of trading on 2 June 2025.

For the purposes of Listing Rule 17.2, Vinyl Group provides the following information:

1. As set out in its request for trading halt dated 29 May 2025 and subsequent announcement on 30 May 2025, Vinyl Group is seeking a voluntary suspension pending the outcome of its proposed application to the Federal Court seeking relief orders in relation to the Company's inadvertent failure to lodge cleansing notices under section 708A(6) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) within the prescribed period.
2. Vinyl Group requests that the voluntary suspension remain in place until Vinyl Group releases an announcement in relation to the outcome of the Federal Court relief application. Vinyl Group will ask that the Court hears the application on an urgent basis and will update the market when a date has been set for the hearing.

Vinyl Group is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
