**ASX Code: CDE – Trading Halt Request**

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Codeifai Limited (ASX:CDE) (**Company**) requests an immediate Trading Halt be granted by the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX) with respect to the Company's securities quoted on the ASX.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1 the Company advises that:

- a) a Trading Halt is requested pending an announcement by the Company responding to a price and volume query letter issued by ASX and the announcement to the market regarding the status of proposed transactions proposed to be undertaken by the Company;
- b) it anticipates that the Trading Halt be effective immediately and remain in place until the earlier of the commencement of normal trading on Wednesday, 11 June 2025 or the release of announcements concerning the above matters;
- c) it is expected that the Trading Halt will end by the Company releasing the announcements concerning the above matters; and
- d) the Company is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted or of any further information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.
