REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION

Rimfire Pacific Mining Limited (ASX: **RIM**) (the **Company**) requests a voluntary suspension be implemented for the Company's ordinary shares (RIM) quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2 prior to the commencement of trading today.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company provides the following information in relation to the request:

1. The Company refers to the stated purpose referred to in the request for trading halt dated 2 July 2025, in relation to the arbitration between Golden Plains Resources Pty Ltd and Rimfire Pacific Mining Limited. The Company also refers to its announcement titled "Arbitration Update" dated 2 July 2025 where the Company advised that it has been unsuccessful in the arbitration and that it may need to request a voluntary suspension to allow the Company sufficient time to consider all of the ramifications and to ensure compliance with the listing rules.
2. The Company has not concluded its consideration of the matters associated with the stated purpose.
3. The Company requests that the voluntary suspension remains in place until the earlier of Friday, 18 July 2025, or when an announcement regarding the status of the stated purpose can be made.
4. The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted or any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
