## TRADE MARK CASE UPDATE

**Zip Co Limited** (ASX: ZIP) (“**Zip**”, or the “**Company**”) provides an update in regard to Firstmac Limited’s trade mark infringement claim against Zip in Australia. Today the High Court of Australia has granted Zip’s application for special leave to appeal the Full Federal Court’s decision of 19 March 2025.

This follows Zip’s prior update on 2 April 2025 in which Zip notified the market of its intention to apply for leave to appeal that decision which was made in favour of Firstmac.

Zip’s appeal will be heard by the High Court at a future date to be determined by the Court. In the meantime, there is no disruption to Zip’s products and services in Australia. Zip also notes these proceedings do not relate to the use of any trade marks by Zip’s US or New Zealand operations.
