

## Australian Patent Granted for NUZ-001 for Neurodegenerative Diseases

### Highlights:

- Australian patent granted covering NUZ-001 for the treatment of neurodegenerative diseases including ALS/MND and others such as Alzheimer's disease, Huntington's disease and Parkinson's disease
- Complements the expedited US patent grant issued earlier this year and provides unified runway through to May 2041 across major global markets
- Patent grant further strengthens global IP portfolio and ongoing work to support NUZ-001 expanded commercialisation opportunities
- Company remains well placed to unlock value from NUZ-001 through entry into HEALEY ALS Platform Trial this quarter

**21 October 2025 – Melbourne Australia:** Neurizon® Therapeutics Limited (ASX: NUZ & NUZOA; OTCQB: NUZTF) ("Neurizon" or "the Company"), a clinical-stage biotech company dedicated to advancing innovative treatments for neurodegenerative diseases, is pleased to advise it has received notice from the Australian Patent Office, informing the grant of a new patent entitled "Use of aminoacetonitrile compounds for the treatment of infection and disease" (patent number 2021272252).

This method of use patent extends protection for Neurizon's lead drug candidate, NUZ-001, and related compounds across key therapeutic areas, including mTOR-pathway related diseases, such as ALS/MND, along with various other neurodegenerative diseases, in particular Alzheimer's disease, Huntington's disease and Parkinson's disease, as well as cancer and infectious diseases.

This newly granted patent complements Neurizon's existing US Patent for NUZ-001 in neurodegenerative diseases and cancer (refer ASX announcement: 5 February 2025) and ensures unified intellectual property (IP) protection through to May 2041 across major global markets.

The Company continues to advance a number of clinical development and commercialisation opportunities for NUZ-001, including entry into the HEALEY ALS Platform Trial expected later this year. Trial entry will be undertaken alongside a range of other initiatives, including ongoing partnerships, licensing and platform therapy development strategies across multiple disease areas.

**Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer, Dr Michael Thurn commented:** "Securing this additional Australian patent was a priority for the management team. It further strengthens our global intellectual property position for NUZ-001 and provides long-term protection across our core markets and a strong foundation for expanding our therapeutic pipeline. With this protection in place, we are ideally positioned to leverage Australia's exceptional early-phase clinical trial capabilities to accelerate development. At the same time, we remain fully committed to our pre-clinical program, showcasing NUZ-001's promise as a platform molecule with potential to address a range of neurodegenerative diseases that currently lack effective treatment options."
