

## DRILLING COMPLETED AT MYSTIQUE GOLD PROJECT

### Highlights

- Aircore **drill program successfully completed** at the Mystique Gold project
- 66 aircore holes (4,262m) drilled testing targets at **Themis South** and **Torquata Gold Prospects** supported by widespread drill intersected gold anomalism in transported cover, saprolite and bedrock
- Final assays expected during November

West Cobar Metals Limited (ASX: WC1) (“West Cobar”, “the Company”) is pleased to announce that drilling has been completed at the Company’s 100%-owned Mystique Project, 240 km east of Kalgoorlie.

A total of 66 air core (AC) holes were drilled (4,262m) testing two gold prospects based on historical gold intersections.
