Request for Trading Halt

Pursuant to Listing Rule 17.1, Enlitic, Inc. (ARBN 672 254 027) (**Enlitic**) requests an immediate trading halt in its quoted securities (ASX Code: ENL), to apply from the open of trading today, Monday, 22 December 2025.

The trading halt is requested pending an announcement by Enlitic to the market regarding the outcome of a proposed capital raising (**stated purpose**).

In accordance with Listing Rule 17.1, Enlitic provides the following information in relation to the request:

- the trading halt is necessary to assist Enlitic in managing its continuous disclosure obligations as the Company expects to make an announcement to the market in relation to the stated purpose;
- Enlitic requests that the trading halt remain in place until the earlier of commencement of trading on Wednesday, 24 December 2025 and a further announcement to the market by Enlitic in relation to the stated purpose;
- Enlitic expects to make the announcement regarding the stated purpose to the market before the commencement of normal trading on Wednesday, 24 December 2025; and
- Enlitic is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.
