Notice under section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth)

Sydney, 24 December 2025 – This notice is given by **Stakk Ltd (ASX:SKK)** (ACN 108 042 593) (Company) under section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) ('Corporations Act'). The Company advises that as detailed in the Appendix 2A announcement dated 24 December 2025, it has completed the issue of 76,923 fully paid ordinary shares (Shares) following the conversion of unlisted options.

 - a. that has been excluded from a continuous disclosure notice in accordance with the ASX Listing Rules; and
 - b. that investors and their professional advisors would reasonably require for the purpose of making an informed assessment of:
 - i. the assets and liabilities, financial position and performance, profits and losses and prospects of the Company; or
 - ii. the rights and liabilities attaching to the Shares.
