Knosys' Greenorbit Intranet business signs customer migration agency agreement with Oak Engage

Knosys Limited (ASX:KNO) ("Knosys" or the "Company") is pleased to announce that its wholly owned subsidiary Greenorbit Pty Ltd (**GO**) has signed an agency agreement with Oak Engage Limited (**Oak**), a company incorporated in England and Wales, to introduce the Oak intranet and employee experience platform (the **Oak Platform**) to the GO customer base.

Background

GO currently provides its Greenorbit intranet solution (the **GO Platform**) to a portfolio of customers, primarily based in Australia and the United States of America. The GO Platform is one of 3 software solutions provided by Knosys to its customer base. The annual revenue from GO customers currently accounts for approximately 30% of Knosys group annual recurring revenues (**ARR**).

As indicated to the market in its periodic reports, Knosys is now primarily focusing its product development resources on its next generation Libero library management solution and is also maintaining its knowledge management solution and its market position.

Knosys has been exploring the means by which GO could continue to provide its customers with an ongoing, up to date and market relevant intranet solution. After due consideration, an agency agreement between GO and Oak has been signed whereby GO will be offering its customers the opportunity to licence the Oak Platform as an upgrade from or replacement for the GO Platform.

Agency agreement summary:

- For an initial 2 year period, GO will act as an agent for Oak, introducing the Oak Platform to GO customers.
- Oak will engage with relevant GO customers introduced by GO to offer the Oak Platform as the ongoing intranet and customer experience solution for those customers.
- Oak and each GO customer may or may not reach agreement for Oak to provide the Oak Platform to the GO customer.
- For an initial 2 year period, from the date upon which a customer migrates to the Oak Platform, GO will act as the billing and collection agent for Oak. At the end of the 2 year period, Oak will take on the direct customer and billing relationship with that customer.
- Whilst noting that there is no guarantee of any customers migrating to the Oak Platform, under this agency agreement Oak will remunerate GO for each GO customer that migrates to the Oak Platform, based on a multiple of that customer's GO ARR. The ARR multiple will be based on the timing of customer migration, the customer's annual subscription date and certain customer retention conditions being met.
- Any GO customers that do not migrate to the Oak Platform will remain on the GO Platform on their current terms.



Managing Director, John Thompson, said, "The Knosys board considers this agreement to be the best outcome for GO customers and Knosys shareholders, as Knosys pursues its current priorities in the Library and Knowledge management markets. By entering this agreement, we access new intranet technology which otherwise would need development and investment by Knosys and its shareholders. Quicker time to market means existing GO customers can access new features and functions to enhance their business operations now."
