

Delisting from the ASX

- **Ryzon to be delisted from the ASX**
- **Shareholders urged to subscribe to news updates on the Ryzon website**

Ryzon Materials Ltd (“**Ryzon**”, or the “**Company**”) (**ASX: RYZ**) announces it has been advised by the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX) that ASX has not provided a further extension to the Company’s removal date and that ASX will remove RYZ from the official list prior to the commencement of trading tomorrow, 21 January 2026.

During the last 3 months the Company has been working on a potential listing on a US Exchange. Currently the Company has received a proposal and is in multiple discussions for various transactions which could expedite a US Listing.

In the last months over \$10m was raised in anticipation of the re-quotation of the Company’s securities on the ASX. With the recent developments, it is expected that a fund raising initiative will be completed in the near future, details of which shall be advised to Shareholders once completed.

As set out in the Company’s September 2025 quarterly activities report, the Company continues to work closely with Xinhai with a focus on moving the Nachu Graphite Project to production in due course.

Following delisting from the ASX, the Company shall continue to meet its continuous disclosure obligations through making announcements on its website <https://ryzon.au>.
