## Resignation of Director

Liontown Limited (ASX : LTR) (**Liontown** or the **Company**) advises that Mr Ian Wells has tendered his resignation as Lead Independent Non-Executive Director, effective 31 March 2026, to accept an executive role as Chief Financial Officer and Group Executive Strategy of Aurizon Holdings Limited.

Mr Wells joined the Liontown Board in January 2024 and has served the Company as Lead Independent Non-Executive Director, Chair of the Audit & Risk Committee and member of the Remuneration & Nomination Committee. He has made a substantial contribution to the Company as it completed construction at Kathleen Valley, commenced production and ramped up operations.

The Company has commenced a search process to identify a suitable candidate to replace Mr Wells on the Board.

Liontown Chairman, Tim Goyder, said:

Ian has played a critical role in promoting continued improvement across the Company's financial, risk and governance systems, and his expertise and guidance have been invaluable as we transitioned from construction to operations at Kathleen Valley.*
