Forrestania Engages Como Engineers for 5 Tonne Modular Pressure Zadra Plant with Gold Room

Highlights:

- Forrestania has engaged Como Engineers for the supply of a fully automated modular 5 Tonne Pressure Zadra Elution complete with Gold Room Equipment, Reagents and Carbon Regeneration Plant. All major equipment, piping, cabling, instrumentation, and valves are fully integrated within the skid structures and will remain installed on the skids for transport.
- The plant will be designed based on high-value modules that will be shipped to site, allowing efficient assembly and minimal on-site construction activities.
- Prior to movement to site, the plant will be fully hot tested and pre-commissioned at Como Engineers' Maddington facility.
- The base cost of the complete Elution Plant is \$5.57 million and will be delivered within 30 weeks.
- Como Engineers was named the 2025 Western Australian Exporter of the Year for their expertise in modular plant design and construction for the minerals processing sector.

Forrestania Resources' Chairman David Geraghty commented:

“This is the first milestone for the conversion of Lake Johnson into our Gold Processing hub, and we are very proud that it’s coming locally from Como Engineers, and within a 30 week delivery time. By integrating all major equipment, piping, cabling, instrumentation and valves within the skid structures prior to transport, on-site construction activities are minimised. The plant will undergo full hot testing and pre-commissioning at Como Engineers’ Maddington facility prior to mobilisation to site, maximising confidence in plant performance ahead of first gold production. Como Engineers was selected for their proven expertise in modular gold processing plant design and construction across Western Australia, as recognised by their 2025 Western Australian Exporter of the Year award.”

Forrestania Resources Limited (ASX: FRS) (“FRS” or “the Company”) is pleased to announce that it has engaged Como Engineers for its ready-to-operate modular Elution and Carbon Regeneration Plant, inclusive of Gold Room equipment.

Strategic Rationale

Ownership of the Lake Johnston processing facility provides Forrestania with a significant strategic advantage within a highly prospective gold province. The addition of a complete, ready-to-operate Gold Room and elution circuit establishes the core gold recovery infrastructure required to complete the processing circuit on site.

By investing in modular, skid-based infrastructure that is assembled and hot-run tested off-site prior to delivery, the Company is reducing installation complexity and supporting efficient commissioning. This approach aligns capital deployment with development milestones and reflects a disciplined execution strategy.

The installation of the Gold Room and elution circuit enhances Forrestania's ability to capture full value from future mining operations and provides flexibility to evaluate multiple feed sources within trucking distance of the Lake Johnston facility.

Payment Structure

The total contract value is approximately \$5.57 million.

The staged payment structure provides clear execution milestones across the 30-week fabrication period, including long-lead equipment procurement, commencement of skid fabrication, factory acceptance testing and final hot-run testing prior to delivery. This structure aligns capital deployment with engineering progress and equipment readiness.

Forrestania continues to advance parallel workstreams across resource development, mine planning and operational readiness as it progresses its transition from gold developer to gold producer.

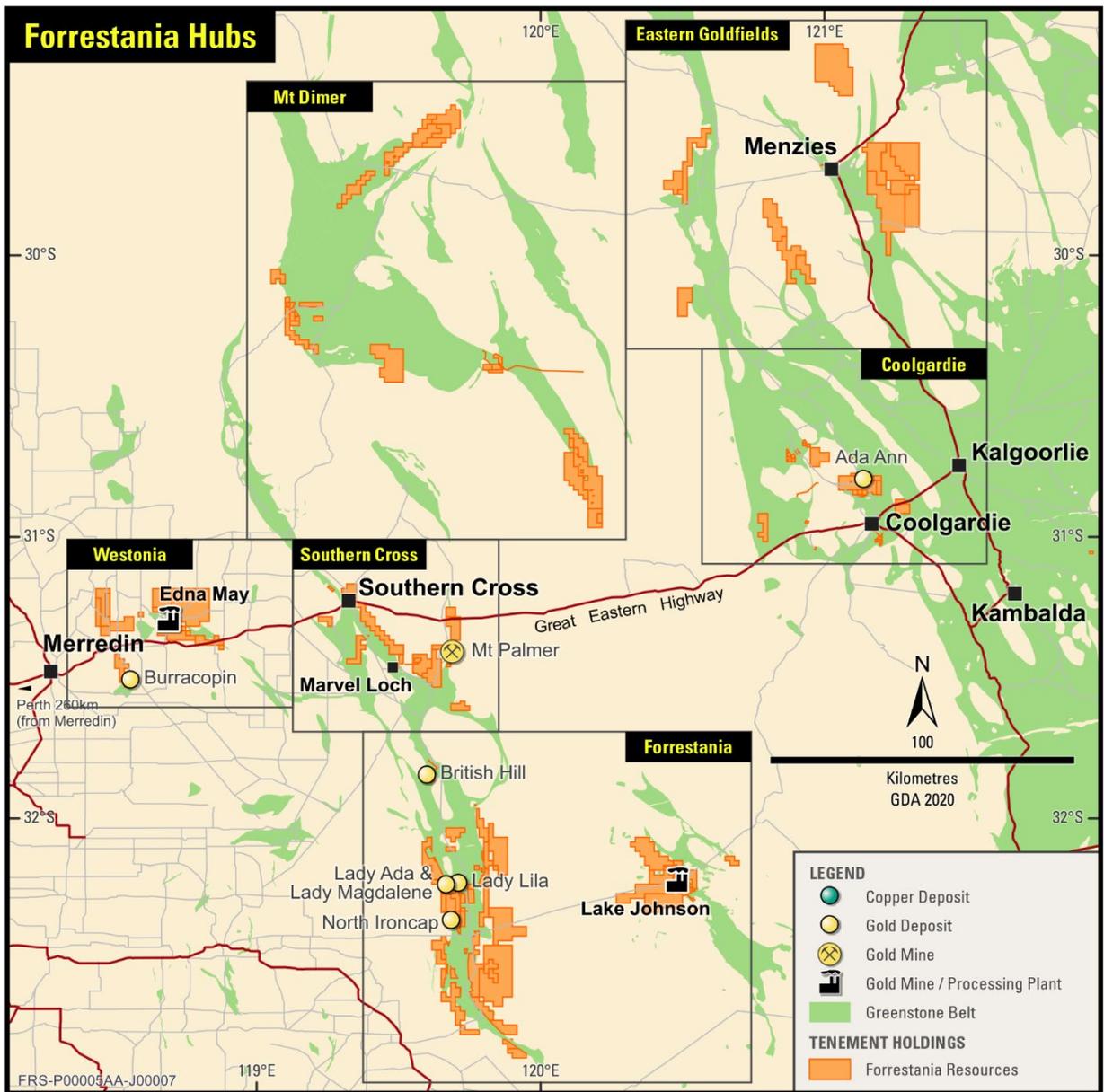


Figure 3. Forrestania Regional Hub locations
