LOI Gas Sale Agreements Update

Central Petroleum Limited (**ASX: CTP**) ("**Central**") refers to its ASX announcement dated 15 December 2025 "*LOI signed for new drilling and long-term gas supply at Mereenie and Palm Valley*". Central and its Mereenie and Palm Valley Joint Venture partners have agreed with Northern Territory's Power and Water Corporation to extend the 20 February 2026 deadline to execute binding Gas Sales Agreements to 2 March 2026.

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This ASX announcement was approved and authorised for release by Leon Devaney, Managing Director and CEO.
