Voluntary Suspension Request

Dear Jakub,

HITIQ Limited (ASX:HIQ) (ACN 609 543 213) (**Company**) requests that ASX grant an immediate voluntary suspension of the Company's HIQOA Listed Options quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2.

The voluntary suspension is requested in respect of an issue in respect of section 723(3) and 724(1)(b)(ii) of the Corporations Act in regard to the issue HIQOA quoted Options on 22 December 2025 (**Purpose**).

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company provides the following information in relation to the request:

1. The voluntary suspension is necessary to assist the Company in managing its continuous disclosure obligations as the Company expects to make an announcement to the market in relation to the stated Purpose above.
2. The Company requests the voluntary suspension to remain in place until the earlier of commencement of normal trading on Tuesday, 3 March 2026 or when the announcement regarding the Purpose is released to the market.
3. The Company expects to make the announcement regarding the Purpose to the market before the commencement of normal trading on Tuesday, 3 March 2026.
4. The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
