The new agreement appoints SuperGrafeo as a distributor for Canada and covers the distribution of First Graphene's PureGRAPH[®] graphene product range.

Expansion into Canada reflects FGR's growing commercial momentum being generated internationally and the strong working relationship developed between the parties under the existing Brazil Distribution Agreement executed in December 2024.

In Canada, SuperGrafeo will focus primarily on distributing PureGRAPH[®] enhanced cement and concrete solutions, as well as bitumen and asphalt additive applications.

Canada's extensive infrastructure network and harsh climate create strong demand for materials delivering improved durability, reduced permeability, crack resistance and longer service life.

The Canadian Government has also committed to working alongside the nation's cement sector to achieve net-zero carbon concrete by 2050¹.

PureGRAPH[®] has demonstrated its ability to enhance mechanical performance and longevity in construction materials, reinforcing First Graphene's position at the forefront of next-generation infrastructure solutions.

First Graphene Managing Director and CEO, Michael Bell, said:

"Extending this relationship into Canada is a natural progression and underscores both First Graphene and SuperGrafeo's confidence in the commercial opportunity presented by this market."

Canada offers substantial opportunity for PureGRAPH[®] in cement and asphalt applications, particularly where durability and sustainability are critical."

We are seeing growing interest and early traction in Canada, and this expanded distributorship strengthens the pathway to advance our North American growth strategy.”

This rising traction reflects broader global trends toward sustainability, performance enhancement and lifecycle cost reduction in construction materials.

The Canadian distribution agreement provides a structured and focused pathway to convert this interest into meaningful commercial outcomes within an industry which contributes \$76 billion each year² to the Canadian economy.

SuperGrafeo is also currently participating in the Propolys incubator program at Polytechnique de Montréal, one of Canada’s leading engineering institutions.

This involvement provides access to advanced research networks, technical validation pathways and industry connections that are expected to accelerate product trials and commercial adoption.

Being embedded within this respected innovation ecosystem further strengthens First Graphene’s presence and credibility in the Canadian advanced materials market.

First Graphene continues to focus on scaling high-quality graphene manufacturing and driving commercial adoption across key industrial sectors, including cement, concrete, composites, elastomers and energy storage.

The expansion of SuperGrafeo’s distributorship into Canada represents another important milestone in the Company’s strategy to establish PureGRAPH® as a globally recognised performance additive for advanced materials.
