FHS obtains judgement in Chile Labour Court Proceeding

Freehill Mining Limited (ASX: FHS 'Freehill' or 'the Company') has received judgement from the Labor Court of La Serena, Chile dismissing all claims made against FHS in a proceeding brought by the wife of a worker that died at Company's Yervas Buenas Project in Chile in July 2024.

As originally announced on 8 July 2024, Freehill was saddened to report that a fatal accident had occurred at the Company's Yervas Buenas Project in Chile. The incident occurred at the site of its smaller fine sand processing plant at Yervas Buenas. Operations were temporarily suspended at the Project until the investigation was concluded by the relevant authorities.

The Labor Court declared that the claims filed were rejected in their entirety and that each party shall pay its own costs in the proceeding.

Employee and contractor safety continues to be a priority for Freehill and its subsidiaries, with well-defined occupational health and safety procedures for all of its workers, contractors and other parties visiting its site.
