LOI Gas Sale Agreements Update

Central Petroleum Limited (**ASX: CTP**) ("**Central**") refers to its ASX announcement dated 24 March 2026 "*LOI Gas Sale Agreements Update*". Central and its Mereenie and Palm Valley Joint Venture partners have agreed with Northern Territory's Power and Water Corporation to extend the 1 April 2026 deadline to execute binding Gas Sales Agreements to 10 April 2026.
