**ROKEBY RESOURCES LIMITED (ASX: RKB) – REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION**

We refer to the trading halt granted to Rokeby Resources Limited (ASX: RKB) (**Rokeby** or the **Company**) on 20 April 2026 pending the release of an announcement by the Company regarding a proposed project acquisition and associated capital raising.

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company requests the voluntary suspension of its securities to apply from the commencement of trading today, Wednesday, 22 April 2026.

For the purposes of ASX Listing Rule 17.2, Rokeby provides the following information:

1. The voluntary suspension is requested as Rokeby has not concluded discussions regarding a proposed project acquisition and associated capital raising.
2. Rokeby requests the voluntary suspension remain in place until the earlier of:
  - a. Rokeby making an announcement regarding the project acquisition and capital raising; or
  - b. The commencement of normal trading on Friday, 24 April 2026.
3. Rokeby is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted.
4. There is no other information necessary to inform the market or ASX about the voluntary suspension.
