ANTAM integrates sustainability principles covering environmental, social, and governance (ESG) aspects through the implementation of responsible mining practices to generate long-term value for stakeholders.

HIGHLIGHTS

Gold sales continued to demonstrate strong performance in 1Q26, supported by resilient domestic demand amid the positive global gold price trend. Sales volume reached 8,464 kg (272,124 troy oz.), and gold production amounted to 201 kg (6,462 troy oz.).

Nickel ore production and sales maintained solid performance in 1Q26, with production volume of 3.88 million wmt and sales of 3.40 million wmt, reflecting sustained domestic demand.

Ferronickel production remained at an optimal level, reaching 3,976 TNi, with sales totaling 2,803 TNi, all of which were absorbed by the export market.

The bauxite and alumina businesses recorded solid fundamental growth in 1Q26. ANTAM recorded bauxite production of 628,785 wet metric tons (wmt) with bauxite sales reaching 593,476 wmt in 1Q26. Meanwhile, Chemical Grade Alumina (CGA) production amounted to 49,566 tons of alumina, with sales totaling 49,072 tons of alumina.

PRODUCTION AND SALES

During the first quarter of 2026 (January–March 2026, 1Q26), ANTAM continued to deliver solid operational performance amid a dynamic global environment, with production and sales maintained at optimal levels. This performance was supported by the Company's strategic response to external factors, including global gold price trends, operational adjustments in the nickel segment in line with the permits/the Work Plan and Budget (RKAB) process, and disciplined operational management across all business lines.

Despite operational dynamics across several commodities influenced by external factors, ANTAM was able to maintain performance stability through disciplined strategy execution, supported by adaptive marketing and effective cost control across all operational segments.

In addition, in carrying out its business activities, ANTAM integrates sustainability principles covering environmental, social, and governance (ESG) aspects through responsible mining practices to create long-term value for all stakeholders.

GOLD

In 1Q26, gold production from the Company's mining operations reached 201 kg (6,462 troy oz.), with gold sales totaling 8,464 kg (272,124 troy oz.).

Global gold price trends influenced by macroeconomic conditions and geopolitical dynamics helped sustain solid domestic demand. ANTAM responded by strengthening its marketing strategies, enhancing precious metals product innovation, and expanding its customer base to capture market growth opportunities.

Supported by resilient operational fundamentals and strengthened gold sourcing, ANTAM has been able to maintain supply availability and sustain its position as one of the leading choices for the public in gold investment.

ANTAM continuously initiates the development of the ANTAM Logam Mulia application as part of the Company's efforts to optimize market potential through a more proactive customer engagement approach. This initiative also strengthens the reliability of the Company's digital service systems to expand market reach, enhance accessibility, and deliver a more integrated customer experience.

NICKEL ORE

ANTAM recorded nickel ore production of 3.88 million wmt and sales of 3.40 million wmt in 1Q26. This performance reflects disciplined operational management amid the utilization of early-year production quotas that were still

based on the previous RKAB, prior to the full approval of the RKAB obtained in March 2026.

All of ANTAM's nickel ore sales in 1Q26 were allocated to the domestic market, both to meet internal demand as raw material for ANTAM's ferronickel plant in Kolaka and for sales to third parties, primarily to supply domestic nickel smelters.

FERRONICKEL

ANTAM's ferronickel performance in 1Q26 was influenced by the linkage between raw material supply and nickel ore RKAB quotas, for which full approval was only obtained in March 2026, as well as the execution of scheduled maintenance activities during the first quarter. Amid these conditions, ANTAM remained able to sustain production continuity and maintain its positioning in the export market.

In 1Q26, ANTAM achieved optimal ferronickel production with output reaching 3,976 tons of nickel in ferronickel (TNi), while ferronickel sales volume amounted to 2,803 TNi.

BAUXITE

ANTAM recorded bauxite production of 628,785 wet metric tons (wmt) in 1Q26. This production achievement was in line with the

optimization of mining capacity and productivity, as well as the growth in domestic market absorption.

ANTAM's bauxite production was utilized as feedstock for the Chemical Grade Alumina (CGA) Plant in Tayan, operated by PT Indonesia Chemical Alumina (PT ICA), as well as for sales to domestic customers.

From a sales perspective, bauxite sales volume in 1Q26 amounted to 593,476 wmt, representing a 9% increase compared to bauxite sales of 544,750 wmt recorded in 1Q25. All of ANTAM's bauxite sales were absorbed by the domestic market.

CHEMICAL GRADE ALUMINA

In line with ANTAM's strategy to optimize the operations of its Chemical Grade Alumina (CGA) Plant in 1Q26, PT Indonesia Chemical Alumina (PT ICA) recorded alumina production in the form of chemical grade alumina (CGA) totaling 49,566 tons of alumina, representing a 13% increase compared to 44,051 tons of alumina in 1Q25.

From a sales perspective, alumina sales volume in 1Q26 reached 49,072 tons of alumina, growing 11% compared to 44,048 tons of alumina recorded in 1Q25.

SUSTAINABLE BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT THROUGH MINERAL DOWNSTREAMING

ANTAM is committed to supporting government policies aimed at enhancing value-added from mining products, strengthening the national economy, and promoting sustainable development. These efforts are aligned with the spirit of Asta Cita in advancing economic transformation, ensuring equitable natural resource management, and enhancing the competitiveness of the national industry.

Referring to the fifth Asta Cita, one of Indonesia's eight national development priority agendas that focuses on downstreaming and industrialization of natural resources to increase domestic value creation, ANTAM continues to strengthen integrated mineral downstreaming initiatives. These efforts are implemented through the development of various mineral downstreaming projects as part of ANTAM's long-term growth strategy, with the objective of generating sustainable value within the domestic economy.

In the gold segment, ANTAM is developing a precious metals manufacturing facility located within the Java Integrated Industrial and Ports Estate (JIPE) in Gresik, East Java, which is currently in the construction phase. This development is aimed at expanding market potential, particularly in meeting the growing retail demand, while enhancing production capacity and increasing the value-added of ANTAM's precious metals gold products.

In the nickel segment, ANTAM has achieved several key milestones in its cooperative project to develop Indonesia's EV battery ecosystem together with CBL Partners (CATL Group). These milestones include the completion of initial works, progress in the permitting process, and funding preparations to support timely construction completion. The project has entered the construction phase in East Halmahera, marked by the commencement of EPC construction activities in the fourth quarter

of 2025 as part of the development of the national EV battery ecosystem.

ANTAM has also continued to strengthen its strategic role in accelerating the development of the integrated national battery ecosystem through a subsequent initiative in collaboration with PT Industri Baterai Indonesia, or Indonesia Battery Corporation (IBC), and strategic partner HYD, led by the global corporation Zhejiang Huayou Cobalt Co., Ltd.

ANTAM, IBC, and the HYD partners signed a Framework Agreement on 30 January 2026, serving as an initial framework to accelerate nickel downstreaming programs and investments in the integrated battery ecosystem. This Framework Agreement provides the foundation for the development of integrated investments from upstream to downstream, encompassing nickel resource management, processing and refining, and battery production.

As part of its efforts to strengthen the downstream development of bauxite commodities, ANTAM continues to promote the integration of the national aluminum industry through the commercial operation of the Mempawah SGAR Project Phase I, which commenced in February 2026, with a production capacity of 1 million tons of alumina per year. The project is operated by PT Borneo Alumina Indonesia (BAI), a joint venture between ANTAM and PT Indonesia Asahan Aluminium (Persero) (INALUM).

In line with this operation, ANTAM and its partners also conducted the groundbreaking of the SGAR Phase II Project in February 2026, which is planned to add up to an additional 1 million tonnes of alumina production capacity per year to be developed in stages. This expansion is intended to strengthen national mineral resilience and ensure the availability of raw materials for the domestic manufacturing industry, as part of efforts to reinforce the national industrial value chain.

EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES

Exploration activities are conducted to ensure the sustainability of the Company's strategic mineral reserves and resources to support long-term business growth. ANTAM's exploration activities focus on gold, nickel, and bauxite commodities to support the continuity of operations as well as development projects. Total exploration expenditure incurred by ANTAM during the 1Q26 period (preliminary, unaudited) amounted to Rp18.35 billion.

As part of its efforts to enhance its gold reserves and resources portfolio, ANTAM is currently prioritizing the identification of additional gold resources, both within existing active mining permit (IUP) areas and in other prospective new areas.

ANTAM through the Geomin Unit undertakes integrated mineral exploration activities which include area survey activities, geological exploration, geophysical exploration, geodesy survey, drilling, physical and chemical analysis, calculation of mineral reserves and resources supported by integrated Geographic Information System (GIS). Exploration activities conducted to ensure the adequacy of the Company's strategic mineral resources and reserves potential.

GOLD

In 1Q26, ANTAM conducted gold exploration activities in Pongkor, West Java. In Pongkor,

ANTAM conducted in underground drilling, surface drilling, traverse survey, geological mapping, sampling, and geochemical analysis.

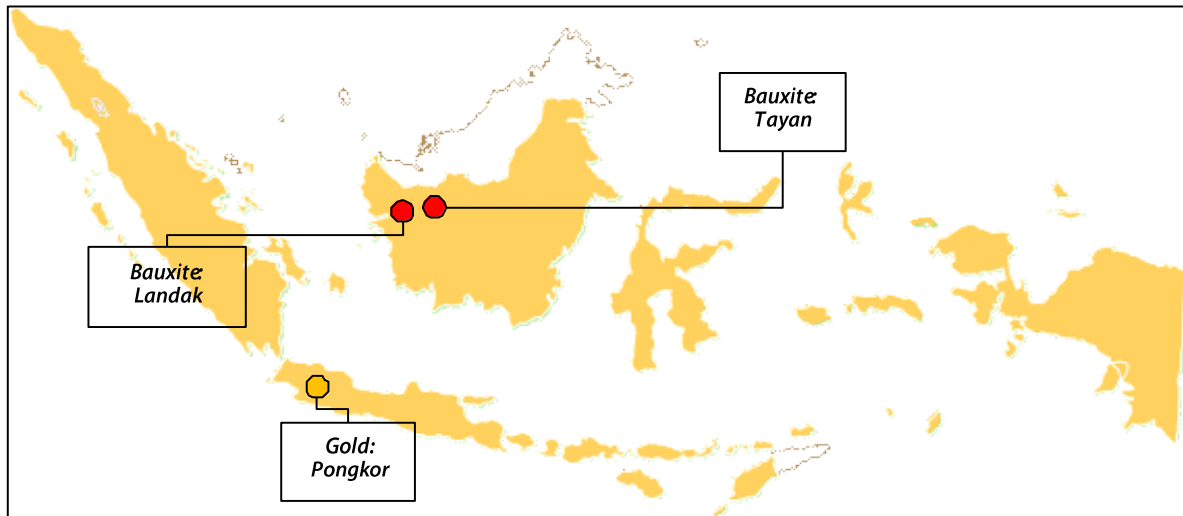
NICKEL

In 1Q26, ANTAM remains in the process of undertaking field preparation activities for the Company's nickel exploration. ANTAM's nickel exploration is planned to North Konawe and Pomalaa, Southeast Sulawesi, as well as within the Mining Business License (IUP) areas of ANTAM's subsidiary, PT Sumberdaya Arindo (PT SDA), in Buli, North Maluku. The exploration program planned for 2026 includes, among others, single-tube drilling, geological mapping, core sampling, core logging, drill hole measurement, geophysical surveys, drilling activities, sample preparation, and sample analysis.

BAUXITE

Bauxite exploration activities in 1Q26 were conducted in Tayan and Landak, West Kalimantan. In the Tayan area, the planned activities conducted drilling, geological mapping, drill hole measurement, and geochemical analysis. Meanwhile the exploration activities until March 2026 are the land identification and permitting. In the Landak area, the activity carried out was geological mapping, land identification and permitting.

ANTAM, IBC, AND HUAYOU STRENGTHEN NATIONAL INTEGRATED BATTERY ECOSYSTEM THROUGH GLOBAL STRATEGIC COLLABORATION

On January 30, 2026 ANTAM, PT Industri Baterai Indonesia or Indonesia Battery Corporation (IBC), together with global strategic partner Zhejiang Huayou Cobalt Co., Ltd., have reaffirmed their joint commitment to accelerating the development of an integrated battery ecosystem in Indonesia through the signing of a Framework Agreement (FA) as the initial framework for

accelerating the Nickel Downstreaming Program and Investment in an Integrated Battery Ecosystem.

This strategic collaboration involves HYD Investment Limited, a consortium of Zhejiang Huayou Cobalt Co., Ltd. and EVE Energy Co., Ltd., as well as PT Daaz Bara Lestari Tbk, as part of efforts to build an integrated battery supply chain from upstream to downstream in Indonesia, from nickel resource management, processing and refining, to battery production.

From the upstream side, ANTAM emphasized its role as a provider of strategic raw materials that are managed responsibly and sustainably. For ANTAM, this collaboration is part of a strategic transformation to ensure that Indonesia’s mineral resources provide maximum added value domestically.

This Framework Agreement serves as the basis for the preparation of a joint feasibility study and definitive agreements to be implemented in stages. ANTAM, IBC, and Huayou is committed to ensuring that all project development stages are carried out in accordance with principles of good governance, sustainability, and national strategic interests.

On March 4, 2026, ANTAM, signed a Gold Sales & Purchase Agreement (GSPA) with PT Bumi Suksesindo (BSI) and PT Puncak Emas Tani Sejahtera (PETS), members of the Merdeka Group holding company.

This collaboration is a strategic step in strengthening national gold sovereignty while ensuring the continuity of domestic gold industry raw material supplies.

Each GSPA is valid for two years with a transaction volume of 6 metric tons of gold per year. In this scheme, ANTAM acts as the buyer, while BSI and PETS act as sellers.

Through this agreement, ANTAM affirms its vision of gold as gold sourced from Indonesian mines, refined at the only and oldest LBMA-certified refinery in Indonesia, and then presented back to the nation as gold that is tested and passed down from generation to generation.
