LED COMMENCES PORTFOLIO REPOSITIONING

LDR Capital Property Fund (ASX: LED) (“**LED**”, or the “**Fund**”) is pleased to announce the exchange of contracts for the sale of 34 Corporate Drive, Cannon Hill for \$24.8 million.

The transaction represents a first step in LED’s strategy to recycling non-core assets and reposition the portfolio toward modern in demand buildings that provide for sustainable and growing distributions.

34 Corporate Drive is a secondary grade office asset located approximately 10 kilometres south-east of the Brisbane CBD. The asset is being sold to Aequitas Group at a 4.6% discount to book value, consistent with current market conditions for comparable secondary office assets.

In the 1H26 financial results, LDR Capital outlined five priority areas including:

- Immediate reduction in fund level expenses
- Detailed review of each asset with acute focus on leasing and property management
- Review of all service contractors (both property and fund level) to improve quality and/or reduce costs
- Explore asset recycling and re-investment opportunities
- Review debt, hedging profile and terms of finance

The Transaction is consistent with LDR Capital’s priority areas.

Paul Lederer, Chairman of LDR Capital said: “Asset recycling is an important first step to repositioning LDR Capital Property Fund. Our goal is simple. Reshape the portfolio to focus on strong defensive cashflows that will underpin a sustainable distribution and NTA growth into the future”.

Proceeds of the sale will initially be used to repay debt. Settlement is expected to occur on 15 June 2026. The Transaction will not impact FY26 distribution guidance.
