

## Livium Executes New Battery Recycling Framework Agreement with CATL

- **Recycling Services Framework Agreement executed with CATL HK, formalising an established relationship with a subsidiary of Contemporary Amperex Technology Co., Limited, the world's leading lithium-ion battery manufacturer**
- **The Agreement establishes a structured framework for Envirostream to provide battery collection, logistics, recycling, certification and reporting services under agreed purchase orders**
- **Services are to be delivered in Australia, with potential for New Zealand, supporting CATL's regional operations and end-of-life battery management requirements**
- **The Agreement has an initial term through to 15 May 2029, positioning Livium to support CATL's regional battery recycling requirements as demand develops**
- **The execution of the Agreement further strengthens Livium's position as a trusted downstream partner to global battery manufacturers and reinforces its role in the circular battery economy**

**Livium Ltd (ASX: LIT) ("Livium" or the "Company")** is pleased to announce that its wholly owned subsidiary, Envirostream Australia Pty Ltd ("**Envirostream**"), has entered into a Framework Contract for Procurement of Recycling Services ("**Agreement**") with Contemporary Amperex Technology (Hong Kong) Limited ("**CATL HK**"), a subsidiary of the world's leading lithium-ion battery manufacturer, Contemporary Amperex Technology Co., Limited.

The Agreement formalises an established working relationship between Envirostream and CATL, under which Envirostream has previously provided battery recycling services on a purchase order basis.

**Livium CEO and Managing Director, Simon Linge commented** *"Formalising our relationship with CATL is an important milestone for Livium. CATL is the global leader in lithium-ion battery manufacturing, and this Agreement reflects their confidence in Envirostream's recycling capabilities and operational standards."*

Under the Agreement, Envirostream will provide battery collection, logistics and recycling services, including dismantling, processing to black mass, certification of recycling and destruction reporting in accordance with regulatory and customer requirements. Services to be delivered under individual purchase orders agreed between the parties. The Agreement is non-exclusive and does not contain minimum volume commitments, with pricing and scope to be determined on a case-by-case basis.

The Agreement has an initial term through to 15 May 2029, unless terminated earlier in accordance with its terms.

### Strategic regional recycling partnership

The execution of this Agreement represents a further step in Livium's strategy to partner with leading global battery manufacturers to support the safe and compliant end-of-life management of lithium-ion batteries.

Formalising the relationship with CATL provides a platform for continued collaboration as battery volumes increase in Australia, while reinforcing Envirostream's role as a critical downstream partner within the battery supply chain.
