VITRAFY LIFE SCIENCES LIMITED (ASX: VFY) – REQUEST FOR TRADING HALT

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Vitrafy Life Sciences Limited (ASX: VFY) (**Vitrafy**) requests an immediate halt in trading of its shares.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, the following information is provided in relation to the request:

- (a) Vitrafy requests the trading halt pending an announcement in connection with a proposed equity capital raising comprising an institutional placement (**Placement**) and security purchase plan.
- (b) Vitrafy requests that the trading halt remains in place until the earlier of:
 - i. the release to the market of an announcement regarding the outcome of the Placement; and
 - ii. the commencement of trading on Friday, 12 June 2026.
- (c) Vitrafy is seeking the trading halt to assist in managing its disclosure obligations, and to ensure that trading does not take place in an uninformed market.
- (d) Vitrafy is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.

The trading halt has been approved for release by the Board of Vitrafy Life Sciences Limited.
