## Tivan awarded Exploration Grant by the NT Government for the Molyhil Tungsten Project

The Board of Tivan Limited (ASX: TVN) (“Tivan” or the “Company”) is pleased to advise that the Company has been awarded exploration grant funding for the Molyhil Tungsten Project (“Molyhil” or the “Project”) in the Northern Territory under Round 19 of the Northern Territory Government’s Geophysics and Drilling Collaborations (“GDC”) program.

The GDC program is a competitive grants program funded by the Northern Territory Government’s Resourcing the Territory initiative, administered by the Northern Territory Geological Survey. The Company was previously awarded grant funding for the Sandover Fluorite Project under Round 18 of the GDC program (see ASX announcement of 6 June 2025) and Sandover AI Project under Round 17 of the GDC program (see ASX announcement of 7 June 2024).

A grant amount of \$141,237 (inclusive of GST) has been awarded towards funding three diamond drill holes totalling ~600m that are planned for the Molyhil Tungsten Project.

The diamond drilling has been designed to test Molyhil-style tungsten-molybdenum magnetite skarn mineralisation associated with a series of coincident gravity and magnetic anomalies identified through detailed geophysical interpretation and 3D modelling. The drilling will assess the source and extent of the anomalies and evaluate their potential to host additional mineralisation outside of the existing Molyhil deposit.

The Molyhil Tungsten Project is located approximately 220 kilometres north-east of Alice Springs in the Northern Territory. Tivan is progressing a Pre-Feasibility Study (“PFS”) for the Project which is focused on proposed mining and processing operations planned to produce a tungsten scheelite concentrate and a molybdenite concentrate for export to global markets. Tivan announced a Scoping Study in April 2026 confirming the technical and economic robustness of the Project on the basis of the study assumptions (see ASX announcement of 29 April 2026).

### Pathway Ahead

Stage 1 drilling at the Project has been completed, which focused on an initial four tungsten targets (see ASX announcement of 7 November 2025 and 9 April 2026). Assay results are expected to be reported soon.

Geophysical surveys across the Molyhil Tungsten Project and Sandover Fluorite Project have also now been completed (see ASX announcement of 18 February 2026). Results are also expected shortly.

Tivan is now progressing planning and approvals for diamond drilling at Molyhil, part of a larger “Stage 2” drilling program planned for the Project, including the application for an Environmental (Mining) Licence with the Department of Lands, Planning and Environment of the NT Government.

Tivan has also materially advanced early and inclusive engagement with Traditional Owners and Native Title Holders, via the Central Land Council, including:



- Establishment of a landmark community development initiative, with Tivan contributing \$1 million to support Indigenous communities in remote Central Australia over the next four years: see ASX announcement of 6 March 2026.
- Central Land Council completing on-country cultural heritage surveys in May.
- Tivan attending an on-country meeting with the Arraperre Native Title Holders at the remote town of Bonya on 2 June 2026.

Tivan is targeting the commencement of Stage 2 drilling in July 2026. This will include exploration drilling and drilling in support of the PFS including resource definition, metallurgical, geotechnical and hydrogeological.

Tivan confirms that the Company has further advanced joint venture discussions with Sumitomo Corporation, consistent with the extension of the Memorandum of Understanding for the collaborative development, funding, marketing and operation of the Project (see ASX announcement of 15 April 2026). Tivan continues to envisage a similar pathway to joint venture that was pursued for the Speewah Fluorite Project, commencing with relevant parties agreeing a “Key Terms Memorandum of Understanding” prior to 30 June 2026.
