## **Fluence Secures Strategic Seawater Desalination Contracts in Vietnam valued at US ~\$3.7 million**

Fluence Corporation Limited (ASX: FLC) (the “Company”) is pleased to announce it has won two (2) significant contracts to supply a series of seawater desalination plants in Vietnam for a prominent Vietnamese infrastructure investor in partnership with SWater Kankyo Corporation (“Swater”), a well-known contractor and strategic business partner in the region. The aggregate contract value is approximately US \$3.7 million for the design and equipment supply of two (2) water treatment plants utilizing multi-media filtration (MMF) and reverse osmosis (RO) technologies.

The plants are expected to be installed and fully operational at Phu Quoc Island in Vietnam before the end of 2026, highlighting Fluence’s ability to meet short delivery timelines for our customers. The facilities will treat seawater sourced from an offshore intake and, upon completion, will be capable of producing up to 7,500 m<sup>3</sup> of high-quality potable water per day. Amid increasing water scarcity challenges in Vietnam, the systems will provide a secure, decentralized supply of water, which is critical to the success of our customer’s project.

Fluence’s high-efficiency quick-to-deploy systems are an ideal solution to meet our customer’s water supply needs and stringent water quality requirements as they are designed to maximize water recovery and sustainability by achieving greater than 45% recovery of feedwater.

“Developers and infrastructure investors in coastal regions of Vietnam are keenly aware that the scarcity of drinking water in the region is a critical issue,” noted Ben Fash, CEO and Managing Director of Fluence. “This project demonstrates how advanced water treatment technology can help our customers secure the water needed for their operations while supporting broader water conservation goals during periods of tight supply.”

“This project reflects a growing shift among infrastructure operators toward sustainable water management strategies such as utilizing decentralized treatment solutions,” added Mr. Fash. “Fluence is very active in Southeast Asia and uniquely positioned to help customers rapidly deploy decentralized treatment systems that improve resilience, reduce environmental impact and protect critical infrastructure operations. These are our 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> contracts with Swater in just over the last year, showcasing a growing partnership that is helping to solve a critical need in the region. We are excited to partner with Swater again, to help them solve the drinking water challenge the end user is facing on this important project. This project demonstrates Fluence’s ability to provide advanced water treatment solutions to many customers facing similar challenges in the Vietnam and throughout Southeast Asia.”
