Yttria Aircore Program Discovers Two Major Gold Trends >600m long

Highlights

- **Maiden 11,000m aircore program locates in-situ gold mineralisation at Yttria**, opening a growth front entirely outside GoldArc's existing 200,000oz JORC resource base.
- **Gold mineralisation traced continuously over 600m along two separate trends**, both open to the south across a 1.4km by 1.2km footprint that remains largely untested.
- **Mineralised holes are coincident with arsenic and tungsten**, the same trace element suite associated with gold at the 137,000oz Mt Stirling deposit, supporting a genetically related system.
- **Results come from wide-spaced first-pass sampling** designed to define target zones ahead of closer-spaced infill drilling.
- **RC drilling at Yttria to test the aircore targets** is planned to follow the ~5,500m RC program at Mt Stirling, which commences early August 2026.

GoldArc Resources Limited (ASX:GA8) ('GoldArc' or 'the Company') is pleased to report results from an 11,000m aircore (AC) program to test for gold mineralisation at Yttria, within its Leonora North project area in the Eastern Goldfields of Western Australia. The program has identified two mineralised corridors over 600m long, sitting entirely outside Yttria's existing REE resource and opening a new gold discovery front within GoldArc's district-scale Leonora North landholding.

The program targeted broad low grade gold anomalies identified during previous vertical vacuum and RC drilling campaigns that were originally focussed on rare earth elements (REE), yttrium (Y), and scandium (Sc) mineralisation. Yttria hosts a JORC Mineral Resource Estimate for the REE mineralisation of 15Mt @ 490ppm TREO¹.

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Yttria is a former REE-focused asset that has never been systematically drilled for gold. The prospect represented a compelling, untested gold target in a district-scale package already recognised for its high-grade gold endowment.

GoldArc Resources Managing Director, Paul Stephen commented: *“Yttria has been sitting in our portfolio as a REE asset, but the geochemistry was telling a very different, gold story. This 11,000m aircore program is our first systematic test of gold potential at Yttria, and it has already located two mineralised corridors over 600m long, each open to the south. We are encouraged by the scale of what we are seeing across the drilled area, and we will now test it with closer-spaced RC drilling.”*

11,000m Aircore drilling program

A total of 363 aircore holes for 11,010m have been completed along 14 drill lines. Line spacing varied between 80m, 160m and approximately 200m, with holes spaced at a nominal 20-30m and drilled to refusal. Hole depth ranged from 1m to 83m, with an average depth of 27.6m. The drilling covered an area of approximately 1.4km by 1.2km, mainly within the P37/8847 and P37/8889 tenements.

Generally, the samples were collected as four-metre composites and the bottom hole samples were collected as one metre samples. All samples were assayed for gold analysed with 25g aqua regia (AR25/MS) and the bottom single metre samples were assayed for a suite of 60 elements analysed with four acid digest (4A/MS) at Genalysis Intertek. The main lithology intercepted in drilling was fine grained low (<1%ppm) Th basalt (Lunnon Basalt equivalent).

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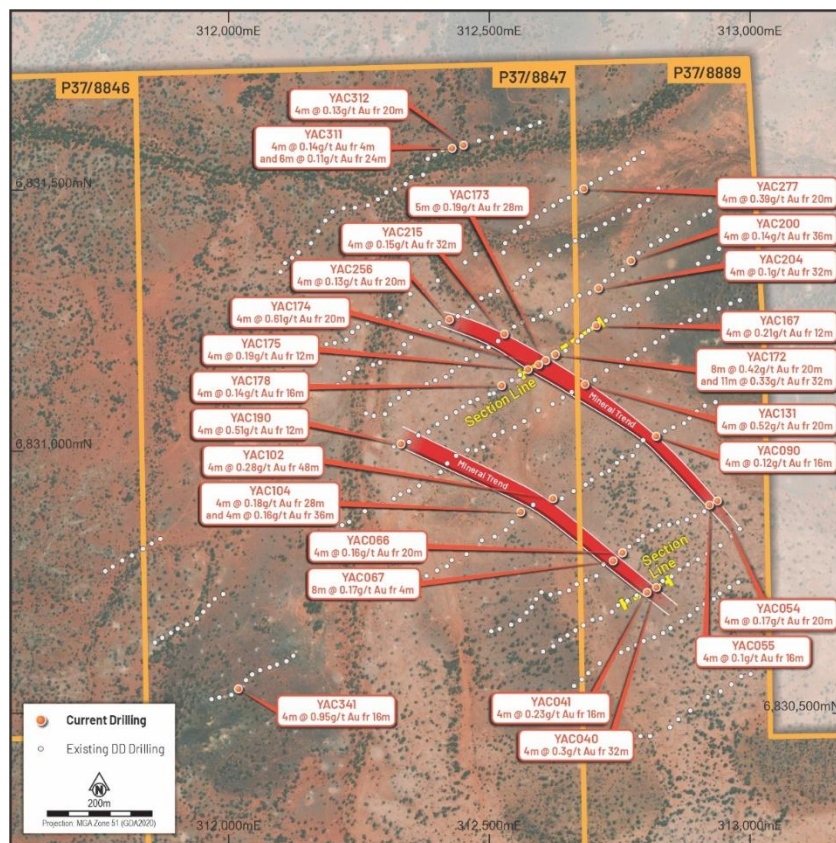


Figure 1 – Plan View of Aircore Drilling over Yttria prospect

Gold Mineralisation Coincident with Mt Stirling Pathfinder Signature

Gold mineralisation was intercepted in numerous aircore holes, generally associated with a deeper weathering profile and, in places, minor quartz veining. Drill fences in the shallower, less weathered northern part of the program were less effective at detecting mineralisation, indicating gold response improves with depth of weathering. Mineralised holes are coincident with arsenic and tungsten, the pathfinder suite associated with gold mineralisation at Mt Stirling, supporting a genetically related system. Two corridors of mineralisation extend for more than 600m and remain open to the south, across areas that have never been drill tested for gold. See Appendix 1 for significant gold intercepts.

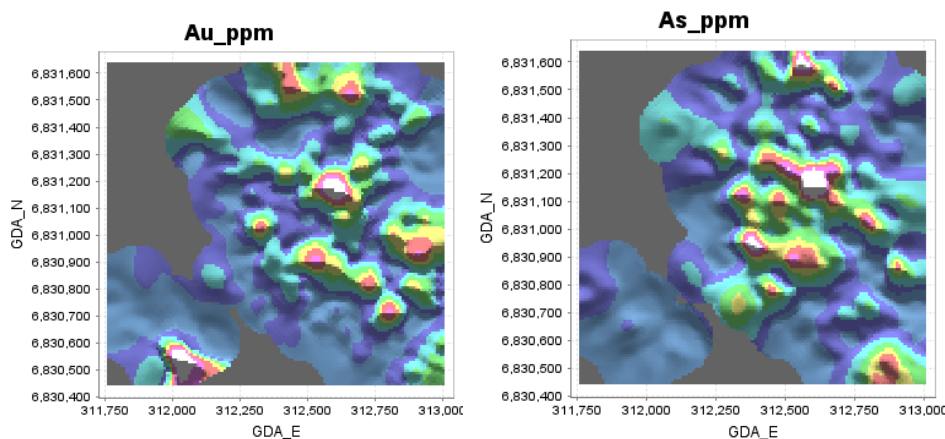


Figure 2 – Heat Map of Au and As at Yttria using GoldArc Aircore Drilling Assays

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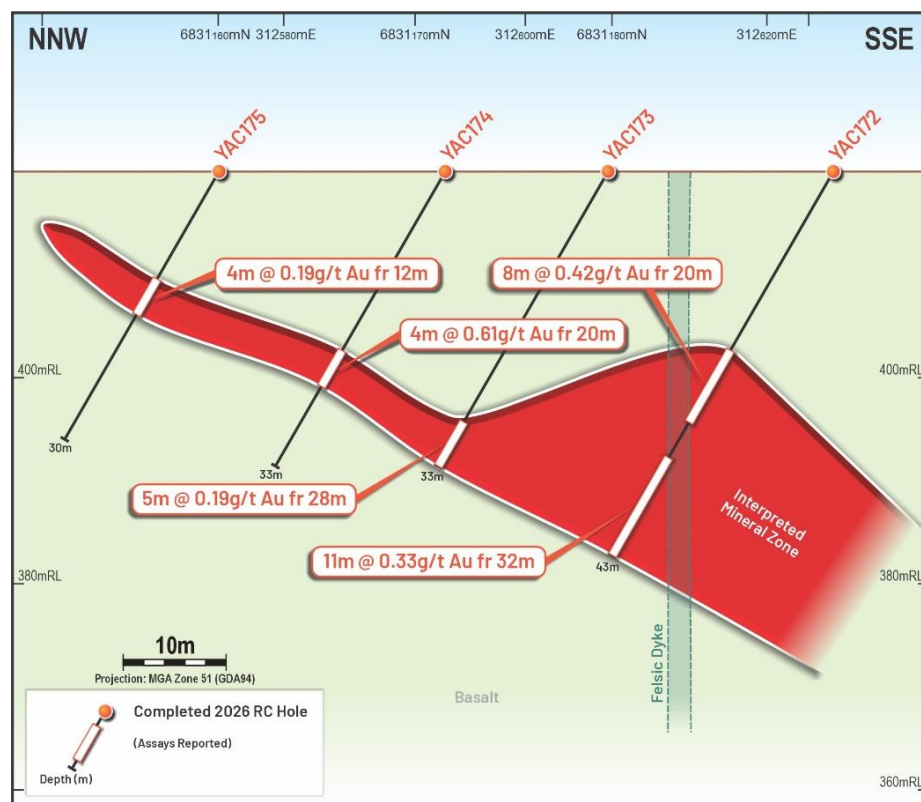


Figure 3 – Cross-section of AC Drilling with gold mineralisation in holes YAC172-175 – Northeastern Trend

The dip of mineralisation varies from 30° to the southwest in holes YAC172-175 to around 45° to the southwest in holes YAC 040-042.

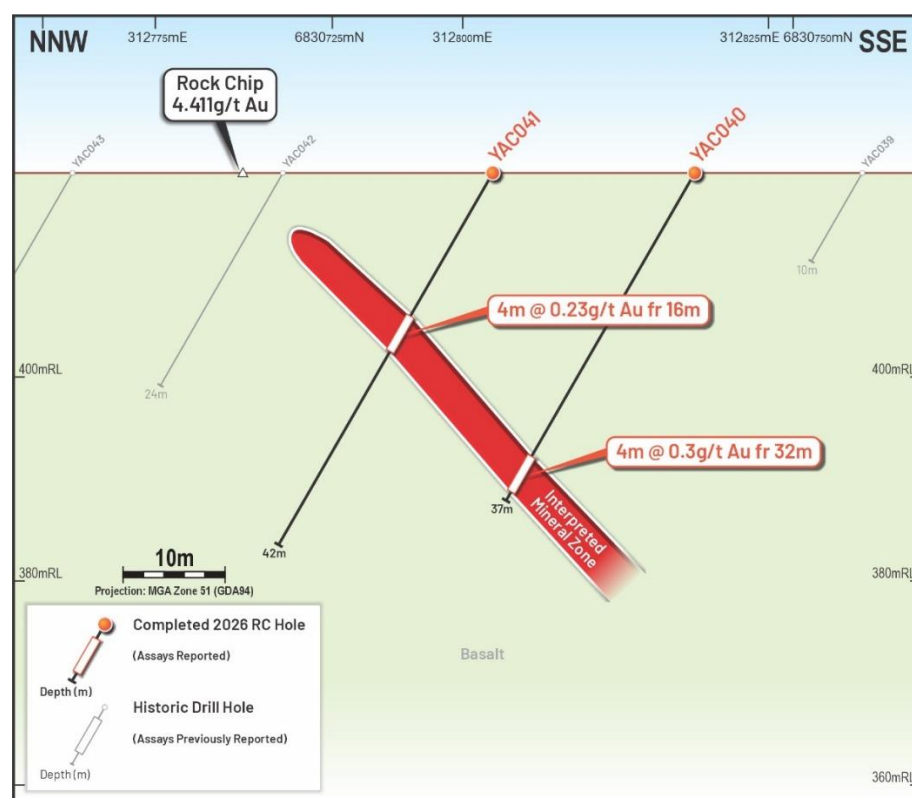


Figure 4 – Cross-section of AC Drilling with gold mineralisation in holes YAC040-042 – Southwestern Trend

Next Steps

The Company is advancing the following near-term milestones:

- Final assay results from Stirling Well are expected within a few weeks.
- Commence a ~5,500m RC program in early August 2026 to test numerous soil gold anomalies around the Mt Stirling deposits.
- Follow up Yttria's two newly defined gold corridors with RC drilling, testing for higher-grade zones at depth and along the open southern strike extent.

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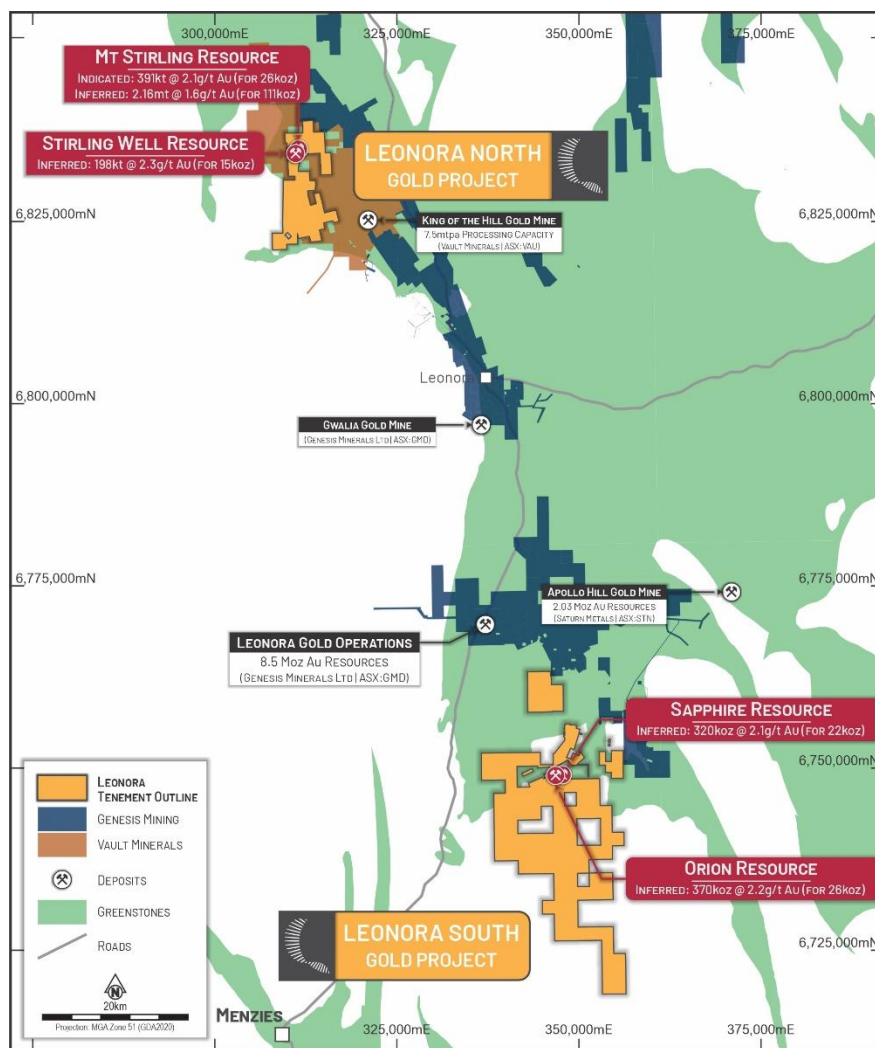
