Norfolk Ciclón Copper Project - SPA Extension

Norfolk Metals Limited (**Norfolk** or the **Company**) refers to its announcement dated 11 June 2026 regarding the proposed acquisition of 100% of Eco Earth Elements SpA and Don Gabriel SpA, which hold the Ciclón Copper Project in Chile (**Ciclón Acquisition**).

The Company advises that it has paid the US\$250,000 extension fee (**Extension Fee**) under the share purchase agreement with Pampa Camarones SpA in respect of the Ciclón Acquisition (**SPA**). The Extension Fee will be deducted from the cash consideration payable by the Company under the SPA on completion of the Ciclón Acquisition.

Accordingly, the date by which the conditions precedent under the SPA must be satisfied or waived (**End Date**) has been extended by two months, from 13 July 2026 to 13 September 2026. The extension is conditional on the Company providing Pampa Camarones SpA, on or before 31 July 2026, with evidence that the Company has either secured commitments for at least US\$60 million under the proposed capital raising (**Capital Raising**) or entered into an underwriting agreement for at least US\$60 million of the Capital Raising.

The Company intends to lodge a prospectus in connection with the proposed underwriting agreement, Capital Raising, and re-compliance with Chapters 1 and 2 of the ASX Listing Rules. An indicative timetable will be included in the prospectus.

The extension assists the Company with adequate time to satisfy the conditions precedent under the SPA, including obtaining the required Shareholder approvals at the General Meeting scheduled for 3 August 2026, satisfying the applicable capital raising condition and obtaining a conditional reinstatement letter from ASX.
