Geophysics fieldwork completed at Srebrenica North

- Phase 1 ground magnetic survey fieldwork has been completed at Srebrenica North, following completion of the maiden soil sampling program.
- Survey is focused on the Zanik and Chaush prospects on the Dolovi Tenement, where historical results returned up to 412g/t Ag, 21.9% Pb, 7.3% Zn and 0.9% Sb and mapped mineralised veins (ASX Ann 31.03.2026).
- The Dolovi tenement borders Mineco's operating Sase (Gross) lead-zinc-silver mine, and immediately adjacent to Terra Balcanica's (CSE:TERA) Viogor-Zanik project.
- First modern, ground-based geophysical exploration conducted across the licence area in over 50 years. A total of 20,000 line-m of initial ground magnetic survey is planned.

Regener8 Resources NL (**ASX: R8R**) (**Regener8** or the **Company**) is pleased to advise the completion of the fieldwork for the Phase 1 ground magnetic survey on the Srebrenica North project (**Project**), following completion of the maiden soil sampling program.

Regener8 Managing Director, Stephen Foley, comments:

"Completing the ground magnetic survey means we now hold two complementary datasets over Zanik and Chaush. The soils give us a surface geochemical fingerprint; the magnetics give us the physical-property information to define structural controls and alteration corridors at depth, including beneath the historical workings at Zanik. Neither dataset would be conclusive alone – read together, and integrated with the field mapping to follow, they are what will allow us to define and rank drill targets. This is the first modern ground-based geophysics over this licence area in more than fifty years, and processing is now underway."



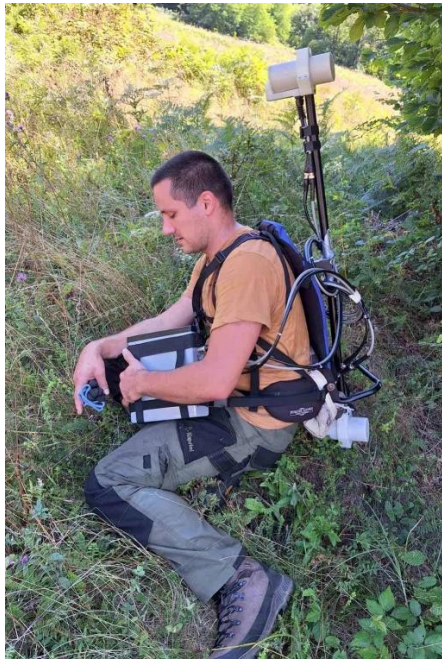


Figure 1: Ground magnetic survey at Srebrenica North

Maiden Ground Magnetic Survey

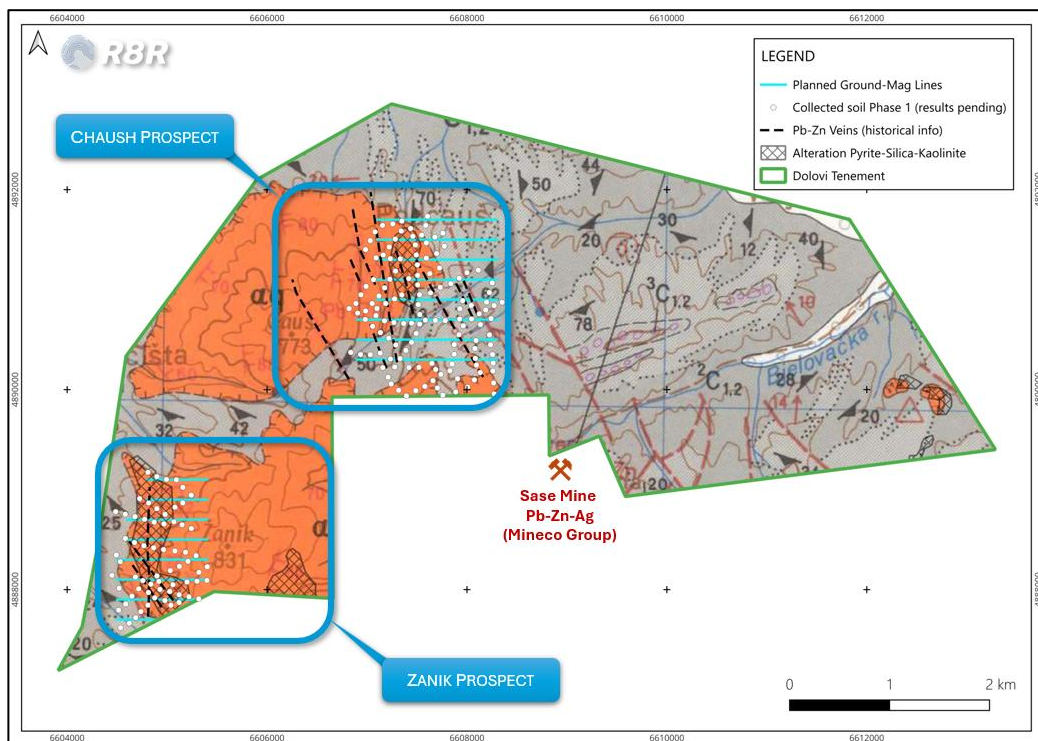


Figure 2: Dolovi tenement, 1:100k geology map (ASX Ann 31.03.2026)

The Phase 1 ground magnetic survey fieldwork is complete over the Zanic and Chaush prospects (Figure 2).

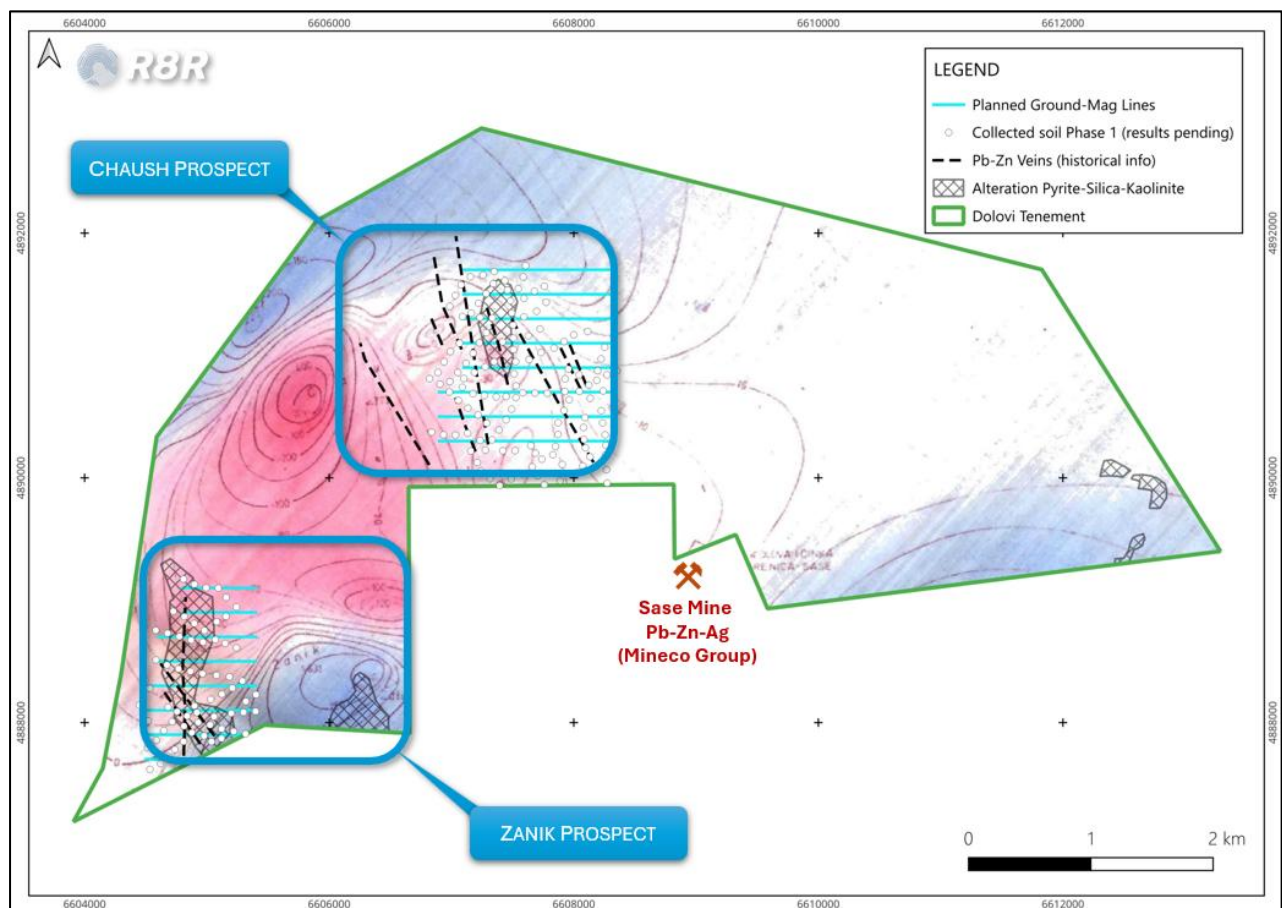


Figure 3: Dolovi tenement, airborne magnetic survey (ASX Ann 31.03.2026)

Zanik (Figure 3), in the south-western Dolovi tenement, was prioritised for early-phase work given the convergence of evidence: substantial medieval workings with a ~2ha waste rock dump, 1975 trench grabs up to **412g/t Ag, 21.9% Pb, 7.3% Zn and 0.9% Sb**, anomalous 1977 stream sediment lead up to **680ppm downstream and 300ppm upstream of the workings** extending into an unexplored central area, and recent reconnaissance identifying gossanous breccia veins 1 – 3m wide with visible galena-sphalerite-pyrite (ASX Ann 31.03.2026). Historical airborne magnetics also show heterogeneity coincident with the mapped alteration and mineralised structures. With Phase 1 soils complete across the prospect, ground magnetics over the same footprint to provide a complementary physical-property dataset, targeting structural controls and alteration corridors beneath the historical workings.

Chaush (Figure 3), in the central Dolovi tenement, is a virgin exploration target with mineralised lead-zinc structures mapped at surface but no recorded historical mining. A coincident airborne magnetic anomaly correlates with mapped hydrothermal alteration, suggesting a favourable geological setting. Phase 1 soils have been completed and ground magnetics will refine the airborne signature, define structural geometry and test for sub-surface continuity of the mapped mineralised system.

Results of the ground magnetic survey will be integrated with the Phase 1 soil geochemistry prior to field geological mapping, to define and prioritise drill-ready targets, with tenement-wide follow-up soils and geophysics planned in subsequent phases.



The Company looks forward to updating the market as exploration progresses.
