archTIS Awarded A\$445,000 Three-Year Spirion SDP Contract

New Private Aviation customer win demonstrates the growing applicability of archTIS' data-centric security portfolio across highly regulated industries

archTIS Limited (ASX:AR9, OTCQB:ARHLF) (“archTIS” or the “Company”), a global provider of data-centric software solutions for the secure collaboration of sensitive information, today announced a new **three-year contract valued at approximately A\$445,000** with a leading U.S.-based private aviation services company.

The agreement expands archTIS' presence into the private aviation sector and further demonstrates the applicability and value of the Company's data discovery, classification and protection technologies beyond its traditional government, defence and national security markets.

The U.S.-based customer operates a large private aviation business across North America and manages significant volumes of sensitive customer, operational and personally identifiable information (PII). The organisation selected archTIS' Spirion Sensitive Data Platform (SDP) to strengthen its enterprise data security posture following an extensive evaluation of its data environment.

Under the three-year agreement, the customer will deploy Spirion SDP across its Microsoft 365 environment, workstations and enterprise file shares, providing enhanced sensitive-data discovery and classification, increased automation, greater accuracy and reduced false positives while complementing the customer's existing Microsoft Purview investment. The initial deployment also creates the opportunity for potential expansion into additional enterprise data sources and applications over the term of the relationship, as well as into the broader archTIS portfolio, including NC Protect, for attribute-based access control, secure collaboration and data protection across Microsoft 365, SharePoint and file shares, and archTIS Trusted Data Integration (TDI), for structured data integration and security policy orchestration at scale.

The contract has a total three-year value of approximately A\$445,000, comprising software licensing, premium support and professional services. The customer has committed to the full three-year term, with payments due annually.

Kurt A. Mueffelman, Chief Strategy Officer and U.S. President of archTIS, stated, "This three-year agreement matters less for its value than for what it demonstrates. Organisations across commercial industries face the same fundamental data security challenges as our government and defence customers: the need to know where sensitive information resides, identifying it accurately and keeping it protected. Private aviation is an excellent example. As we expand archTIS in North America, we see significant opportunity to apply the capabilities we have built in some of the world's most demanding security environments across a much broader range of regulated commercial markets."

Expanding Addressable Vertical Markets

The win represents another step in archTIS' strategy to broaden the application of its data-centric security portfolio into commercial markets where organisations manage highly sensitive or regulated information.

While archTIS has established its technology within defence, government and national security environments, the same fundamental challenges, discovering, classifying, controlling and protecting sensitive information, exist across aviation, financial services, healthcare, critical infrastructure, technology and other regulated industries.

Private aviation is a particularly data-intensive market, combining high-net-worth customer information, Personally Identifiable Information (PII), operational records and other sensitive data distributed across cloud platforms, endpoints and legacy file repositories.

The customer selected Spirion SDP based on its accuracy and customisation, low false-positive rates, integration with Microsoft Purview, automation capabilities, and ability to discover sensitive information in areas outside Purview's existing scope. The deployment is initially focused on file shares, workstations and Microsoft 365, with potential expansion into additional enterprise platforms.

The contract further supports archTIS' strategy of building longer-term recurring customer relationships while expanding its addressable market across both public-sector and commercial organisations.
